

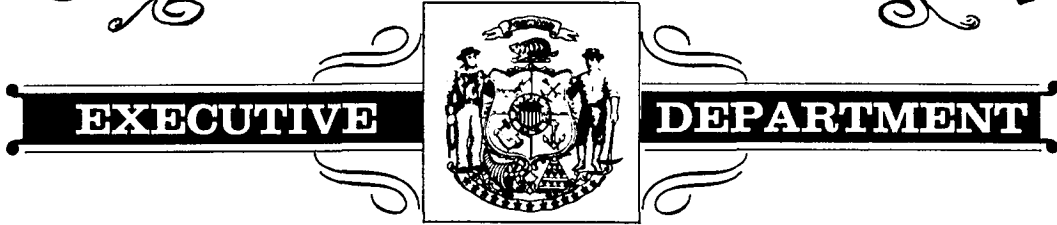

1. Certificate of Graaskamp's Membership to the Governor's Committee on Eminent Domain, November 26, 1968

The State of Wisconsin



To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:

Know Ye, That I, Governor of the State of Wisconsin, reposing special Trust and Confidence in his Integrity and Ability do hereby appoint PROFESSOR JAMES GRASSKAMP, of Madison, as a member of the Governor's Committee on Eminent Domain;

And I hereby authorize the exercise of the powers and the duties of that office according to his discretion, to serve for an indeterminate term.



In Testimony Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and caused the Great Seal of the State of Wisconsin to be affixed. Done at the City of Madison, this 26th day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand nine hundred and sixty-eight.

Governor:
